

## **RAYMOND D. BARRETT JR.**

### **Major General, U.S. Army, Retired**

A distinguished Military Graduate of the University of Texas Army ROTC program, Major General Raymond D. Barrett, Jr. was commissioned in the Infantry in 1972. He holds a Bachelor of Business Administration Degree in Accounting from the University of Texas at Austin, a Master of Business Administration Degree in Management from the University of Dayton, and Master of Military Arts and Science Degree from the Army Command and General Staff College. His military schooling includes Airborne, Air Assault, and Ranger schools, as well as the US Army Command and General Staff College, School of Advanced Military Studies and Army War College.



Major General Barrett commanded the 3rd Battalion, 15th Infantry Regiment with the 24th Infantry Division during Desert Shield and Desert Storm. His numerous command and staff positions since then include commanding the 2d Brigade, 2d Infantry Division in the Republic of Korea, Chief of Staff of the 24th Infantry Division at Fort Stewart, Georgia, and Assistant Division Commander, 2d Infantry Division, again in the Republic of Korea. He also served as the Deputy Director for Operations, Headquarters US Pacific Command at Camp Smith, Hawaii and Deputy Chief of Staff for Operations and Training at the Army's Training and Doctrine Command. Major General Barrett was the 31st Commanding General of the United States Army Training Center and Fort Jackson, SC.

Upon his retirement from the Army in 2004, Major General Barrett joined HNTB Corporation, an international Engineering, Architecture and Planning firm, as Vice President. With HNTB he involved in strategic planning, leadership development and business development.
