His most recent assignment was as the briefer to the Associate Director for Military Affairs. He has a bachelor's from the United States Military Academy, a Master of Science in Strategic Intelligence from the Defense Intelligence College, a JD from the George Mason University School of Law, and a Master of Military Art and Science from the U.S. Army School of Advanced Military Studies.
