#### **Colonel Arthur D. Simons Center for Interagency Cooperation**

The Simons Center for Interagency Cooperation is a research, analysis, study and publication center focused on interagency issues at the tactical and operational levels. The Simons Center supports and encourages scholarship at CGSC by providing opportunities for faculty and student research and publication. Publication support includes the *InterAgency Journal* and *InterAgency Papers*, *Essays* and *Study* series. Simons Center publications are used throughout the whole-of-government to inform more effective interagency cooperation.

#### **Academic Research and Scholarly Outreach**

The Foundation provides grants for faculty and student research and participation in scholarly conferences that government funds cannot support. The program is competitive: faculty and students apply to the College Graduate Degree Program Committee and are selected for participation. The CGSC Foundation News magazine is a semi-annual publication that supports the outreach mission. The magazine is intended to inform alumni as well as the civilian community about the Foundation and the College. The magazine received an award for excellence in its category in 2012 from a national nonprofit agency. The magazine is distributed to nearly 9,000 recipients at the College and nationwide. ### **Comprehensive Soldier and Family Fitness programs**

After 13 years of continuous conflict, our military members and their families are under significant stress. This program supports Soldiers and their families in reconnecting and reintegrating, as well as providing life skills for all family members. The Foundation supports the Comprehensive Soldier Fitness program and the Master Resiliency Training Course for military spouses conducted by CGSC as elective courses for students and their spouses. In addition, the Foundation provides materials and activity items in support of the Ike Skelton Combined Arms Research Library annual youth reading programs, as well as the summer youth reading programs.
